



NPSSSA: Tournament & Fun Night
Scoring Rules 2023 – Revised 6/10/2023
 1st/2nd Grade, 3rd/4th Grade & 5th/6th Grade Groups

POINTS:	
Win:	6 points
Tie:	3 points
Loss:	0 points
Goals Scored:	1 point per goal (max of 3)
Shut-out:	1 additional point
Goal Diff. of > 6	Deduction of 1 point (-1) for every instance of a goal differential of >6 for the winning team

(A Maximum of 10 Total points possible for each game)

***** To Prevent any teams from Running up the Score, ONE Point will be deducted from the winning team's total if a goal differential of greater than 6 points occurs within a game. *****

Scoring Examples:

- Team 1 v 2 Final Score is 5-0
 - **Team 1:** Earns 10 points (6 points for the win + 1 point for shut-out + 3 points for Goals 1-3) points
 - **Team 2:** Earns 0 points

- Teams 3 v 4 Final Score is 3-2
 - **Team 3:** Earns 9 points (6 points for the win + 3 points for goals 1-3)
 - **Team 4:** Earns 2 points (0 points for loss + 1 point for each goal scored (2)).

- Teams 5 v 6 Final Score is 9-2
 - **Team 5:** Earns 8 points (6 points for the win + 3 points for goals 1-3, Deduction of 1 point for the >6 goal differential)
 - **Team 6:** Earns 2 points (0 points for loss + 1 point for each goal scored (2)).

At the conclusion of the three Soccer Mini-Games,
 the team with the most points is the First-Place team.
3rd/4th Grade & 5th/6th Grade Groups: 1st & 2nd Place teams will be identified
1st/2nd Grade Group: 1st, & 2nd, and 3rd Place teams will be identified

Tie Breakers:

- **Two-way Tie:**
 - Head-to Head
 - Total Goal differential in all games played (maximum of 3 per game).
 - Team allowing the least total goals in all games played
- **Three-way Tie** (in each case, if the rule eliminates 1 team, then use 2-way):
 - Total Goal differential in all games played (maximum or 3 per game).
 - Team allowing the least total goals in all games played
- **Four-way Tie** (in each case, if the rule eliminates 2 teams, then use 2-way)
 - Total Goal differential in all games played (maximum of 3 per games).
 - Team allowing the least total goals in all games played

*** In the event of a first-place tie after all rules have applied, a sudden death overtime will be played, first team to score wins the first-place title. ***
